**THE SUPERANNUATION (RAILWAY EMPLOYEES) ORDER  
1963**

PURSUANT to the Superannuation Act 1956, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

**ORDER**

1. (1) This order may be cited as the Superannuation (Railway Employees) Order 1963.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 21st day of April 1963.

2. It is hereby declared that the allowances specified in the Schedule hereto, being allowances paid to certain employees of the New Zealand Government Railways Department, shall be deemed to be salary for the purposes of Part II of the Superannuation Act 1956.

**SCHEDULE**

**ALLOWANCES DEEMED TO BE SALARY**

1. Supervisory allowances paid to bus drivers, service-car drivers, motor-  
lorry drivers (route), and tradesmen in Class 7 (Road Services).

2. Supervisory allowances paid to storemen in Class 6 (Stores and  
Sawmills) in charge of sub-stores.

3. Allowances paid to employees reduced in status because of ill health.

4. Chargehand allowance paid to certain tradesmen in Class 5 (Work-  
shops and Depots).

5. Allowances paid to signalmen in "A" box Wellington, "A" box  
Auckland, and other important signal boxes as defined by the General  
Manager.

6. Allowances paid to chargehand tradesmen in Class 5 (Workshops  
and Depots).

7. Allowance paid to patternmakers in Class 5 (Workshops and Depots).

8. Allowance paid to moulders (other than machine moulders) when capable of undertaking and prepared to undertake floor and jobbing moulding as and when required.

9. Allowance paid to storemen in Class 6 (Stores and Sawmills) when in charge of stores sections as determined by the General Manager.

10. Allowances paid to "A" grade and certified motor mechanics in Class 7 (Road Services).
