ORDER IN COUNCIL

At Wellington this 26th day of June 1989

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 23 (8) of the State-Owned Enterprises Act 1986, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the State-Owned Enterprises (Landcorp) Order 1989.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 1st day of July 1989.

2. Application of section 23 (8) of State-Owned Enterprises Act 1986 to land, etc., transferred to Landcorp—Subsection (8) of section 23 of the State-Owned Enterprises Act 1986 applies to all land, interests in land, licences, permits, and rights created on terms and conditions wholly or partly set out in the Land Act 1948 that have at any time (before or after the commencement of this order) been transferred to Land Corporation Limited, or to any subsidiary (within the meaning of section 158 of the Companies Act 1955) of Land Corporation Limited, pursuant to the State-Owned Enterprises Act 1986.

3. Terms and conditions set out in Land Act 1948 to apply—For the purpose of their continued application in respect of the land, interests, licences, permits, and rights described in clause 2 of this order, there are

hereby specified the terms and conditions set out in the following provisions of the Land Act 1948: Sections 18, 26 (1), 50, 50A to 50F, 56, 60, 60B, 63, 65, 67 (1), 67 (2), 67 (4), 68 to 69, 81 to 105, 111 to 115, 121 to 126, 127, 130 to 151, 153 to 158, 160 to 164B, 170 to 171, 174, and 183.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order, which comes into force on 1 July 1989, provides for the continued application (with all necessary modifications) of a number of provisions of the Land Act 1948 to land, interests in land, licences, permits, and rights created on terms and conditions set out in that Act, where the land, interests, licences, permits, or rights have been transferred to Landcorp or any of its subsidiaries.
