ORDER IN COUNCIL

At Wellington this 20th day of December 1993

Present:

HER EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 10a of the State-Owned Enterprises Act 1986 (as inserted by section 2 of the State-Owned Enterprises Amendment Act 1992), Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the State-Owned Enterprises Order 1993.
 - (2) This order shall come into force on the 1st day of January 1994.
- 2. Addition to First and Second Schedules to State-Owned Enterprises Act 1986—The State-Owned Enterprises Act 1986 is hereby amended by inserting in the First and Second Schedules, in each case in its appropriate alphabetical order, the following item:
 - "Vehicle Testing New Zealand Limited."
- **3. Addition to First Schedule to Ombudsmen Act 1975**—The Ombudsmen Act 1975 is hereby amended by inserting in Part II of the First Schedule, after the item relating to the Transport Accident

Investigation Commission (as inserted by section 16 of the Transport Accident Investigation Commission Act 1990), the following item:

"Vehicle Testing New Zealand Limited."

4. Addition to Fourteenth Schedule to Income Tax Act 1976—The Income Tax Act 1976 is hereby amended by inserting in the Fourteenth Schedule (as substituted by section 23 (1) of the State Services Conditions of Employment Amendment Act 1987), in its appropriate alphabetical order, the following item:

"Vehicle Testing New Zealand Limited."

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order, which comes into force on 1 January 1994, provides for the creation of a new State enterprise, Vehicle Testing New Zealand Limited.

Clause 2 adds the name of the new State enterprise to the First and Second Schedules to the State-Owned Enterprises Act 1986.

Clause 3 includes the name of the new State enterprise in Part II of the First Schedule to the Ombudsmen Act 1975. The company will thus become subject to that Act and to the Official Information Act 1982 on that date.

Clause 4 includes the name of the new State enterprise in the Fourteenth Schedule to the Income Tax Act 1976 (which Schedule relates to the grouping of tax losses).
