



**THE SUPERANNUATION EMERGENCY REGULATIONS 1940,
AMENDMENT NO. 1**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington, this 19th day of
May, 1943

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Emergency Regulations Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Superannuation Emergency Regulations 1940, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Superannuation Emergency Regulations 1940* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. The principal regulations are hereby amended by inserting, after Regulation 3, the following regulation :—

“ 3A. Where any person has, whether before or after the commencement of this regulation, elected pursuant to Regulation 3 hereof to cease contributing to any Superannuation Fund he shall not be entitled to contribute to that Fund in respect of any period after the date of the taking effect of that election, and the amount of the retiring-allowance to which he may afterwards be entitled on his actual retirement shall be computed as if he had retired on the date of the taking effect of that election and as if his service had terminated accordingly on that date.”

3. Regulation 3 of the principal regulations is hereby consequentially amended by omitting the words “ and in any such case the said period shall not be taken into account in computing the amount of retiring-allowance to which he may afterwards be entitled on retirement ”.
