REGULATIONS 1991**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At Wellington this 2nd day of April 1991

THE HON. D. C. MCKINNON PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 80 of the Survey Act 1986, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Survey (Departmental Fees and Charges) Regulations 1991.

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 28th day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Fees and charges—There shall be payable to the Department for the services specified in the Schedule to these regulations the appropriate fees and charges specified in that Schedule.

3. Amount to be fixed where range of fees or charges prescribed—Where any provision in the Schedule to these regulations prescribes a range of fees or charges payable in respect of any service, the Director-General shall in each case fix within that range the fee or charge that is

payable, having regard to the actual costs and expenses involved in supplying that service.

4. Time-based charges—Where these regulations provide that the standard time-based charge is payable in respect of any service, the charge payable in any case shall be an amount calculated by the Director-General and shall comprise—

- (a) The cost of salaries incurred in respect of the provision of the service; and
- (b) A reasonable overhead charge; and
- (c) Goods and services tax payable under the Goods and Services Tax Act 1985.

5. Miscellaneous charges—(1) Reasonable disbursements incurred by the Department in supplying any service specified in the Schedule to these regulations shall be payable in addition to the appropriate fees and charges specified in that Schedule.

(2) Where any machine or instrument is used or hired out in connection with the supply of any service, there shall be payable in addition to the appropriate fees and charges specified in the Schedule to these regulations the cost of that use or the hire cost, plus a reasonable return on capital to be fixed by the Director-General having regard to the expected life and usage of that machine or instrument.

6. Refund or waiver of fees and charges—The Director-General may authorise the refund or waiver of any fee or charge payable under these regulations, in whole or in part, in any case where the service—

- (a) Involves the supply of a product in bulk; or
- (b) Involves the supply of maps to any person appointed by the Director-General as a retailer of the Department's maps; or
- (c) Involves the supply of a product for use under or in connection with a licence granted by the Department; or
- (d) Is supplied for charitable purposes; or
- (e) Is supplied for promotional or publicity purposes.

7. Fees and charges inclusive of goods and services tax—The fees and charges prescribed by or fixed under these regulations are inclusive of goods and services tax under the Goods and Services Tax Act 1985.

8. Revocation—The Survey (Departmental Fees and Charges) Regulations 1989* are hereby consequentially revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force 28 days after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*, prescribe new fees and charges payable under the Survey Act 1986. The new fees and charges are inclusive of goods and services tax under the Goods and Services Tax Act 1985.

Issued under the authority of the Acts and Regulations Publication Act 1989.

Date of notification in *Gazette*: 4 April 1991.

These regulations are administered in the Department of Survey and Land Information.
