THE SALT-WATER FISHERIES AMENDMENT REGULATIONS, 1937.

Enacting authority: His Excellency the Governor-General in Council.

Act pursuant to which the regulations were made: The Fisheries Act,
1908.

Date on which the regulations were made: 9th day of April, 1937. Date of notification in *Gazette*: 15th day of April, 1937.

REGULATIONS.

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Salt-water Fisheries Amendment Regulations, 1937.
- 2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the regulations made on the 29th day of June, 1932,* with respect to fish, shell-fish, and other matters (hereinafter called "the principal regulations") and the amendments thereof.
- 3. The regulation made on the 24th day of June, 1936,† prohibiting trawling in the Bay of Islands is revoked.
- 4. The principal regulations are amended by adding thereto following Regulation 55 thereof the following regulations:—
- "55A. On and after the 4th day of November, 1937, no person shall, during the months of November, December, January, and February in any year, trawl or use a trawl-net or a Danish seine net for the purpose of taking fish within the tidal waters respectively specified within the following boundaries:—

" Bay of Islands.

"Inside a straight line drawn from Cape Wiwiki to the northern extremity of Red Head on Red or Okahu (Okahi) Island, and thence in a straight line drawn in a northerly direction to the northern extremity of Cape Brett.

" Doubtless Bay.

- "Inside a straight line drawn from Knuckle Point to Flat Head (Bergens Point), as the said area is delineated on the plan marked M.D. 7422, and deposited in the office of the Marine Department at Wellington.

"Rangaunu Bay.

"Inside a straight line drawn from Grenville Point (Gravell Point) to the northernmost end of the northern island of the Moturoa Islands, and thence to Cape Karikari (Karaka).

"55B. No person shall use a Danish seine net for taking fish within the waters hereinafter specified—namely, all those waters within one marine league extending from the south bank of the Waitaki River, in Otago Province, to Long Point in the same province."

5. Regulation 56 of the principal regulations is amended by inserting therein after the word "inclusive" the words "or of Regulation 55A

or Regulation 55B".
