## THE SALT-WATER FISHERIES AMENDMENT REGULATIONS 1937, NO. 4.

Enacting authority: His Excellency the Governor-General in Council. Act pursuant to which the regulations were made: The Fisheries Act, 1908.

Date on which the regulations were made: 8th day of December, 1937. Date of notification in *Gazette*: 16th day of December, 1937.

## REGULATIONS.

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Salt-water Fisheries Amendment Regulations 1937, No. 4.
- 2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the regulations made on the 29th day of June, 1932,\* with respect to fish, shell-fish, and other matters (hereinafter called "the principal regulations") and the amendments thereof.

3. The principal regulations are amended by inserting therein, next following Regulation 55A thereof, the following additional regulation:—

"55B. In waters in which the use of a Danish seine net for the purpose of taking fish is for the time being absolutely forbidden no person shall use for the purpose of taking fish any net which is drawn over the sea-bottom or through the sea by two vessels or by means of engine power:

"Provided, first, that this regulation shall not apply to the waters comprising Lyttelton Harbour and adjacent waters within a straight line drawn from the lighthouse on Godley Head to Wakaroa Point on the eastern side of Pigeon Bay:

- "Provided, secondly, that in the waters mentioned in the preceding proviso no person shall use a net with a warp or rope of a length exceeding 360 fathoms attached to either wing thereof."
- 4. The principal regulations are amended by inserting therein, next following Regulation 135 thereof relating to trawling, the following additional regulation:—
- "135A. In waters in which the use of a trawl-net for the purpose of taking fish is for the time being forbidden no person shall use for the purpose of taking fish any net which is drawn over the sea-bottom or through the sea by means of engine power:

"Provided, first, that this regulation shall not apply to the waters comprising Lyttelton Harbour and adjacent waters within a straight line drawn from the lighthouse on Godley Head to Wakaroa Point on the eastern side of Pigeon Bay:

"Provided, secondly, that in the waters mentioned in the preceding proviso no person shall use a net with a warp or rope of a length

exceeding 360 fathoms attached to either wing thereof."
