THE SALT-WATER FISHERIES AMENDMENT REGULATIONS 1939, NO. 3.

GALWAY, Governor-General. ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House at Wellington, this 27th day of September, 1939.

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to the Fisheries Act, 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Salt-water Fisheries Amendment Regulations 1939, No. 3.
- 2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the regulations made on the 29th day of June, 1932,* with respect to fish, shell-fish, and other matters (hereinafter called the principal regulations) and the amendments thereof.
- 3. These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of October, 1939.
- 4. Regulation 114 (e) of the principal regulations is amended by adding thereto the following proviso:—
- "Provided that in respect of any area described in Regulation 124 hereof, the period in the year 1939 during which it shall be unlawful for the licensee of any such area to take toheroa therefrom shall be the months of November and December."
