THE SHIPPING (FEE FOR EXAMINATION OF PLANS OF SHIPS) NOTICE 1970

PURSUANT to the Shipping and Seamen Act 1952, the Minister of Marine hereby gives the following notice.

NOTICE

1. Title and commencement—(1) This notice may be cited as the Shipping (Fee for Examination of Plans of Ships) Notice 1970.

(2) This notice shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Fee for examination of plans of ships—The fee payable under section 196 of the Shipping and Seamen Act 1952 for the examination of the plans and specifications of a ship shall be—

Ships not exceeding 100 feet register length \$60.00.
Ships exceeding 100 feet register length \$60.00, plus an additional \$60 for each additional 50 feet or part thereof.

3. Revocation—The Shipping (Fee for Examination of Plans of Ships) Notice 1963* is hereby revoked.
