**THE SURGICAL FOOTWEAR NOTICE 1956,
AMENDMENT NO. 1**

PURSUANT to the Social Security (Hospital Benefits for Outpatients) Regulations 1947,* the Minister of Health hereby gives the following notice.

N O T I C E

1. This notice may be cited as the Surgical Footwear Notice 1956, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Surgical Footwear Notice 1956† (hereinafter referred to as the principal notice).

2. Clause 3 of the principal notice is hereby amended by revoking paragraph (e), and substituting the following paragraph:

“(e) That a sum that equals half the cost of any artificial aid but does not in any case exceed £4 shall be recoverable from the person to whom it is supplied:”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This notice provides for recovery from the person to whom surgical footwear is supplied of a maximum sum of £4, instead of the former maximum sum of £2 10s.
