PURSUANT to the Fisheries Act, 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Seal Fishery Regulations 1946, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Seal Fishery Regulations 1946* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. (1) Regulation 3 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the words "31st day of March, 1948", and substituting the words "31st day of March, 1954".

(2) The Seal Fishery Regulations 1946, Amendment No. 1, are hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE
