ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 23rd day of June 1969

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Fisheries Act 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. **Title**—These regulations may be cited as the Seal Fishery Regulations 1946, Amendment No. 8, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Seal Fishery Regulations 1946* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. **Close season for seals**—(1) Regulation 3 of the principal regulations (as amended by regulation 2 (1) of the Seal Fishery Regulations 1946, Amendment No. 7) is hereby further amended by omitting the words “31st day of March 1969”, and substituting the words “31st day of March 1972”.

(2) Regulation 2 of the Seal Fishery Regulations 1946, Amendment No. 7, is hereby revoked.
