# THE SEAL FISHERY REGULATIONS 1946, AMENDMENT NO. 8

#### ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 23rd day of June 1969

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Fisheries Act 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

### REGULATIONS

- 1. Title—These regulations may be cited as the Seal Fishery Regulations 1946, Amendment No. 8, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Seal Fishery Regulations 1946\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- 2. Close season for seals—(1) Regulation 3 of the principal regulations (as amended by regulation 2 (1) of the Seal Fishery Regulations 1946, Amendment No. 7) is hereby further amended by omitting the words "31st day of March 1969", and substituting the words "31st day of March 1972".
- (2) Regulation 2 of the Seal Fishery Regulations 1946, Amendment No. 7, is hereby revoked.
