THE STATE FOREST REGULATIONS AMENDMENT, 1936.

Enacting authority : His Excellency the Governor-General in Council.

Act pursuant to which the regulations were made : Section 63 of the Forests Act, 1921–22.

Date on which the regulations were made: 23rd day of December, 1936.

Date of notification in *Gazette* : 8th day of January, 1937.

REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the State Forest Regulations Amendment, 1936.

2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the State Forest Regulations made under the State Forests Act, 1908, on the 31st day of March, 1909* (hereinafter referred to as "the principal regulations").

3. These regulations shall come into force on the **31st** day of December, 1936.

4. Regulations amending the principal regulations made on the 21st day of February, 1917,[†] are hereby revoked.

5. Clause 31 of the principal regulations is hereby revoked, and the following substituted therefor :---

"31. No timber shall be sold except at such price or at such rates as the Commissioner of State Forests may determine."

6. Clauses 46 and 47 of the principal regulations are hereby amended by deleting the word "royalty" wherever it occurs, and substituting therefor the words "purchase price".
