THE SAMOA HIGH COURT AMENDMENT RULES, 1936.

Enacting authority: His Excellency the Governor-General in Council Act pursuant to which the regulations were made: The Samoa Act 1921.

Date on which the regulations were made: 30th day of September, 1936.

Date of notification in *Gazette*: 15th day of October, 1936.

His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of that Dominion, and in pursuance of the authority conferred on him by the Samoa Act, 1921, and of all other powers and authorities enabling him in that behalf, doth hereby amend the Rules of the High Court of Western Samoa Consolidation, 1924, as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Samoa High Court Amendment Rules, 1936.
2. This Order shall be read with and form part of the Rules of the High Court of Western Samoa Consolidation, 1924.*
3. Paragraph (e) of Rule 4 of the Rules of the High Court of Western Samoa Consolidation, 1924, is hereby amended by deleting therefrom the words " or originating summons ".
