PURSUANT to the Samoa Act 1921, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following rules.

RULES

1. These rules may be cited as the Samoa High Court Amendment Rules 1952, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Rules of the High Court of Western Samoa Consolidation 1924* (hereinafter referred to as the principal rules).

2. Rule 40 of the principal rules is hereby amended by adding to subclause (1) the following paragraph :—

“(f) A Samoan medical practitioner.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

[*This note is not part of the rules, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*]

These rules enable affidavits to be sworn in Samoa before Samoan medical practitioners, in addition to the persons previously prescribed, namely—Solicitors, Registrars and Deputy Registrars of the High Court, Postmasters, Collectors of Customs, and Medical Officers.
