THE SAMOA IMMIGRATION AMENDMENT ORDER 1938.

GALWAY, Governor-General.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House at Wellington, this 29th day of June, 1938.

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to the Samoa Act, 1921, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following Order.

ORDER.

1. This Order may be cited as the Samoa Immigration Amendment Order 1938.

2. This Order shall be read together with and form part of the Samoa Immigration Order 1930* (hereinafter called "the principal Order"), as amended by the Samoa Immigration Amendment Order 1935.†

3. This Order shall come into force on the 11th day of July, 1938.

4. Clause 2 of the principal Order is amended by inserting next following subclause (1) thereof the following additional subclauses:—

"(2) No person shall without the previous written permission of the Administrator land in Samoa from any place outside Samoa at any other place than the Customs Wharf at Savalalo in the Port of Apia.

"(3) It shall be a defence to any proceedings for a breach of the last preceding subclause if the person charged proves that he so landed in consequence of shipwreck or wreck of aircraft or reasonably to escape peril of the sea or the air."

5. Clause 2 of the principal Order is further amended by assigning to subclause heretofore numbered (2) thereof the number "(4)".

6. Clause 4 of the principal Order is amended by adding to subclause (7) thereof (as heretofore amended) the following words: "or to a person one or both of whose parents were born in Samoa."

7. Clause 17 of the principal Order is amended by inserting in subclause (1) thereof (as heretofore amended) next after the words "lawful for the Administrator" the following words: "notwithstanding that such labourer, domestic servant, or artisan has already resided in Samoa for five years."

8. Clause 18 of the principal Order (as heretofore amended) is further amended by inserting after paragraph (c) thereof the following additional paragraph:—

"(d) A person one or both of whose parents were born in Samoa."
