ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 28th day of March 1955

Present:

THE RIGHT HON. S. G. HOLLAND PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Stock Act 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Stock Importation Amending Regulations 1955, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the regulations made under the Stock Act 1908 on the 4th day of October 1915, and published in the *Gazette* on the 7th day of the same month at page 3420 (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. Regulation 9 of the principal regulations, as set out in regulation 6 of the Stock Importation Amending Regulations 1947* and as amended by regulation 3 of the Stock Importation Amending Regulations 1951† is hereby further amended by omitting from paragraph (a) of sub-clause (4) the words "and the Avian tuberculin test", and substituting the words "and the complement-fixation test for Johne's disease".

3. The Fourth Schedule to the principal regulations, as substituted by regulation 9 of the Stock Importation Amending Regulations 1947* and as amended by regulation 4 of the Stock Importation Amending Regulations 1951,† is hereby further amended:

(a) By omitting from paragraph (c) of form No. 4 the words "and the Avian tuberculin test":

(b) By inserting, after paragraph (e) of the said form No. 4, the following paragraph:

"(f) That within the period aforesaid – namely on the day of 19..... – I subjected the said cattle to the complement-fixation test for Johne's disease with negative results."

EXPLANATORY NOTE

[This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.]

These regulations require that the veterinarian's certificate to accompany cattle imported from Great Britain shall show that he has subjected the cattle to the complement-fixation test for Johne's disease instead of the Avian tuberculin test as required under the existing regulations.
