THE STOCK IMPORTATION AMENDING REGULATIONS 1956

HIS EXCELLENCY THE ADMINISTRATOR OF THE GOVERNMENT IN COUNCIL

Pursuant to the Stock Act 1908, His Excellency the Administrator of the Government, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Stock Importation Amending Regulations 1956, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the regulations for the prevention of the introduction into New Zealand of diseases affecting stock made under the Stock Act 1908 on the 4th day of October 1915, and published in the Gazette on the 7th day of the same month at page 3420 (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of June 1956, and shall apply to stock introduced into New Zealand on and after that date.
- 2. The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the Fifteenth Schedule, as set out in regulation 13 of the Stock Importation Amending Regulations 1939, and substituting the Fifteenth Schedule set out in the First Schedule to these regulations.
- 3. The charges payable for the transport of stock to and from quarantine and for the sustenance and care of stock while in quarantine in respect of stock introduced into New Zealand before the 1st day of June 1956 shall be those which would have been payable if these regulations had not been passed.
- 4. The regulations specified in the Second Schedule hereto are hereby revoked.
