THE SHIPPING LIFESAVING APPLIANCES RULES 1960, AMENDMENT NO. 2

Pursuant to the Shipping and Seamen Act 1952, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following rules.

RULES

- 1. (1) These rules may be cited as the Shipping Lifesaving Appliances Rules 1960, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Shipping Lifesaving Appliances Rules 1960* (hereinafter referred to as the principal rules).
- (2) These rules shall come into force on the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.
- 2. Rule 11 of the principal rules is hereby amended by omitting from subclause (6) the words, "Such additional lifebuoys or lifejackets", and substituting the words "Such additional buoyant apparatus, liferafts, lifebuoys, or lifejackets".
- 3. (1) Rule 44 of the principal rules (as amended by rule 10 of the Shipping Lifesaving Appliances Rules 1960, Amendment No. 1) is hereby further amended by omitting from subclause (3) the words, "Class III, Class IV, or Class V", and substituting the words "Class III, Class IV, or Class X".
- (2) Rule 10 of the Shipping Lifesaving Appliances Rules 1960, Amendment No. 1, is hereby revoked.
- 4. The Ninth Schedule to the principal rules is hereby amended by omitting from paragraph (q) of clause (2) of Part III the words "Part VIII of the Thirteenth Schedule", and substituting the words "Part III of the Sixth Schedule".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the rules, but is intended to indicate their general effect. Rule 2 permits the provision of buoyant apparatus or liferafts to make up the balance of lifesaving equipment required in extended river limit passenger ships. At present lifebuoys and lifejackets only are required.

Rule 3 corrects an error in rule 10 of the Shipping Lifesaving Appliances

Rules 1960, Amendment No. 1.

Rule 4 corrects an incorrect reference in the Ninth Schedule to the principal rules.
