ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington, this 15th day of October, 1947

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Samoa Act, 1921, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. This Order may be cited as the Samoa Legislative Council (Elective Membership) Amendment Order 1947.

2. This Order shall be read together with and form part of the Samoa Legislative Council (Elective Membership) Order 1923 (hereinafter called the principal order).

3. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in clause 29 of the principal order, the election of members to the Legislative Council required to be held in the month of November, one thousand nine hundred and forty-seven, in accordance with the said clause 29, is postponed to a day to be fixed by the Administrator, such day not being later than six calendar months from the last day of November, one thousand nine hundred and forty-seven.

4. For the purpose of fixing the date of subsequent elections, in accordance with clause 29 of the principal order, the election postponed by clause 3 of this Order shall be deemed to have been held in the month of November, one thousand nine hundred and forty-seven.
