**THE SOUTHERN LAKES FISHING REGULATIONS 1965,
AMENDMENT NO. 1**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 31st day of August 1966

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Fisheries Act 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Southern Lakes Fishing Regulations 1965, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Southern Lakes Fishing Regulations 1965* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Regulation 2 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by inserting in paragraph (b) of the definition of the term "open season" in subclause (1), after the words "Tasman Sea", the words "between Makawhio Point and Puysegur Point".

3. Regulation 14 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by adding to subclause (1) the following paragraphs:

"(d) That portion of the Moeraki River that lies upstream from Lake Moeraki:

"(e) The Windbag Stream."

4. Regulation 24 of the principal regulations is hereby amended—

(a) By revoking paragraph (f):

(b) By omitting from the proviso the words "(not being a multiple hook)".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

Regulation 2 is intended to clarify the meaning of the term "open season" in relation to the rivers flowing into the Tasman Sea.

The effect of regulation 3 is to close to fishing the portion of the Moeraki River lying upstream from Lake Moeraki and also the Windbag Stream.

Regulation 4 revokes the provision prohibiting the use of any lure having a multiple hook.
