

## THE SOUTHERN LAKES FISHING REGULATIONS 1965, AMENDMENT NO. 2

At the Government House at Wellington this 27th day of April 1970 Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Fisheries Act 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

## REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Southern Lakes Fishing Regulations 1965, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Southern Lakes Fishing Regulations 1965\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the date of their notification in the Gazette.
- 2. Duration of principal regulations—Regulation 1 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking subclause (3).
- 3. Close season for quinnat salmon—Regulation 14 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by inserting, after subclause (1), the following subclause:
- "(1A) Notwithstanding anything in subclause (1) of this regulation or in paragraph (b) of the definition of the term "open season" in subclause (1) of regulation 2 of these regulations, no person shall on or after the 1st day of September 1970 fish for, take, or kill quinnat or spring salmon (Oncorhynchus tschawytcha) in any river, lake, or stream draining into the Tasman Sea between Makawhio Point and Puysegur Point, or in any tributary of any such river or stream, or in any river or stream flowing into any such lake, or in any tributary of any such lastmentioned river or stream."

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

The effect of regulation 1 is to continue the principal regulations in force after 31 August 1970, the date with which they would otherwise expire.

Regulation 2 prohibits the taking at any time on or after 1 September 1970 of quinnat or spring salmon in any rivers, lakes, or streams draining into the Tasman Sea between Makawhio Point and Puysegur Point.
