PURSUANT to section 87 of the Student Loan Scheme Act 1992, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting on the advice and with the consent of the Executive Council, makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Student Loan Scheme (Repayment Threshold) Regulations 1999.
 - (2) These regulations come into force on 1 April 2000.
- 2. Repayment threshold—The repayment threshold that, for the purposes of the Student Loan Scheme Act 1992, applies in respect of the income year commencing on 1 April 2000 and each subsequent income year is \$14,768.

3. Revocation—The Student Loan Scheme (Repayment Threshold) Regulations 1997 (S.R. 1997/340) are consequentially revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 1 April 2000, prescribe, under section 87 of the Student Loan Scheme Act 1992, the repayment threshold that is to apply in respect of the income year commencing 1 April 2000 and each subsequent year.

The repayment threshold so prescribed is \$14,768.
