Regulations

1 Title

These regulations are the Student Loan Scheme (Repayment Threshold) Regulations 2001.

2 Commencement

These regulations come into force on 1 April 2002.

3 Repayment threshold

The repayment threshold that, for the purposes of the Student Loan Scheme Act 1992, applies in respect of the income year commencing on 1 April 2002 and each subsequent income year is \$15,496.

4 Revocation

The Student Loan Scheme (Repayment Threshold) Regulations 2000 (SR 2000/278) are revoked.

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 1 April 2002, prescribe, under section 87 of the Student Loan Scheme Act 1992, the repayment threshold that applies in respect of the income year commencing 1 April 2002 and each subsequent year.

The repayment threshold prescribed is \$15,496.
