

## THE STIPENDIARY MAGISTRATES (TRAVELLING-ALLOWANCE) AMENDMENT REGULATIONS 1948

## THE RIGHT HON. P. FRASER PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 10 of the Magistrates' Courts Act, 1928, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

## REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Stipendiary Magistrates (Travelling-allowance) Amendment Regulations 1948, and shall be read together with and form part of the regulations made under section 10 of the Magistrates' Courts Act, 1928, on the 2nd day of July, 1934, and published in the *Gazette* on the 5th day of the same month at page 2093 (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking Regulation 1 hereof as heretofore amended, and substituting the following :—

"1. Stipendiary Magistrates shall receive travelling-allowance at the rate of 27s. 6d. a day for every period of absence on duty from headquarters during which they are necessarily absent from their usual place of residence at night."

**3.** The regulation made on the 14th day of July, 1936, and published in the *Gazette* on the 23rd day of the same month at page 1396, the regulations made on the 13th day of September, 1944, and published in the *Gazette* on the following day at page 1117, and the regulations made on the 29th day of August, 1945, and published in the *Gazette* on the 6th day of the following month are hereby revoked.
