THE SAMOA NATIVE REGULATIONS 1938, AMENDMENT NO. 1.

GALWAY, Governor-General.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House at Wellington, this 3rd day of April, 1940.

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to the Samoa Act, 1921, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Samoa Native Regulations 1938, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read with and form part of the Samoa Native Regulations 1938.*

2. Clause 14 of the Samoa Native Regulations 1938 is revoked, and the following clause substituted therefor:—

“ 14. Every person who owns or occupies or has control over persons who own or occupy any Samoan house—

“(a) For which sufficient privy accommodation is not provided either independently or in common with other houses; or

“(b) The privy accommodation for which (if consisting of a pit privy) is constructed or maintained otherwise than as required by clauses 11, 12, and 13 hereof,—

is liable to a fine not exceeding £2.”
