**THE SUSPENSION OF APPRENTICESHIP EMERGENCY
REGULATIONS 1939, AMENDMENT NO. 3.**

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

November, 1941.

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to the Emergency Regulations Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Suspension of Apprenticeship Emergency Regulations 1939, Amendment No. 3.

2. These regulations shall be read together with and deemed part of the Suspension of Apprenticeship Emergency Regulations 1939* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

3. Regulation 12 of the principal regulations, as substituted by Regulation 7 of the Suspension of Apprenticeship Emergency Regulations 1939, Amendment No. 2, is amended by revoking the words "subject, however, to such terms and conditions relating to wages or otherwise as may be laid down in modification of the contract by an Apprenticeship Committee" and substituting the following: "at the wage rate prescribed for the last six months of the apprenticeship contract, plus half the difference between that rate and the journeymen's rate calculated on the basis of a forty-hour week".
