Pursuant to section 18 (1) of the Shipping and Seamen Act 1952, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Shipping (Certificates of Competency as A.B.) Order 1976.
- (2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the Gazette.
- 2. Countries whose certificates of competency as A.B. are recognised in New Zealand—It is hereby declared that certificates of competency as A.B. granted by or under the authority of the Governments of any of the countries specified in the Schedule to this order shall be of the same force as those granted under the Shipping (Certificates of Competency as A.B.) Regulations 1954* and shall have effect as if they had been granted under those regulations.
- **3. Revocation**—The Shipping (Certificates of Competency as A.B.) Order 1960† is hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect. This order replaces the Shipping (Certificates of Competency as A.B.) Order 1960. The order is in similar terms to the 1960 order except that Ghana, the Federal Republic of Nigeria, and Barbados are now included in the list of countries whose certificates of competency as A.B. are recognised in New Zealand.
