# Regulations

### 1 Title

- (1) These regulations are the Status of Children (Fees) Amendment Regulations 2001.
- (2) In these regulations, the Status of Children (Fees) Regulations 1995<sup>1</sup> are called "the principal regulations".

### 2 Commencement

These regulations come into force on 3 October 2001.

## 3 Fees prescribed

- (1) Regulation 3(1)(a) of the principal regulations is amended by omitting the expression "\$20", and substituting the expression "\$35".
- (2) Regulation 3(1)(b) of the principal regulations is amended by omitting the expression "\$20", and substituting the expression "\$35".

These regulations, which come into force on 3 October 2001, amend the fees payable for search and certification services under the Status of Children (Fees) Regulations 1995.
