Pursuant to the Shipping and Seamen Act 1952, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

- 1. Title—This order may be cited as the Shipping (Recognition of Certificates of Competency) Order 1965, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Shipping (Recognition of Certificates of Competency) Order 1965* (hereinafter referred to as the principal order).
- 2. United Kingdom fishing certificates—(1) The principal order is hereby amended by inserting, after clause 2, the following clause:
- "2A. It is hereby declared that the certificates specified in the first column of the Second Schedule to this order granted under the authority of the Government of the United Kingdom shall be of the same force and effect as if they were certificates granted under the Shipping and Seamen Act 1952 of the respective kinds specified in the second column of that Schedule, and shall have effect as if they had been so granted."
- (2) The principal order is hereby further amended by adding the Second Schedule set out in the Schedule to this order.
