



THE STATUS OF CHILDREN (FEES) REGULATIONS 1995

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At Wellington this 4th day of September 1995

HER EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 11 (1) (a) of the Status of Children Act 1969, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Status of Children (Fees) Regulations 1995.

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Interpretation—In these regulations, “the Act” means the Status of Children Act 1969.

3. Fees prescribed—(1) There are hereby prescribed—

(a) For a search of any index kept under section 9 (2) of the Act, \$20:

(b) For the issue of a certified copy of any instrument, or duplicate or copy of any instrument, filed under section 9 (1) of the Act, \$20.

(2) No fee shall be payable for a certificate under paragraph (d) of subsection (2) of section 9 of the Status of Children Act 1969 setting out the result of any search under paragraph (a) of that subsection.

4. Goods and services tax included—The fees prescribed by regulation 2 (1) of these regulations are inclusive of goods and services tax under the Goods and Services Tax Act 1985.

5. Consequential revocation—The Status of Children (Fees) Regulations 1989 are hereby consequentially revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force the day after notification in the *Gazette*, prescribe fees for the purposes of the Status of Children Act 1969.
