PURSUANT to the Superannuation Act 1956, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. (1) This order may be cited as the Superannuation (Post Office Employees) Order 1963.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 19th day of April 1963.

2. It is hereby declared that the allowances specified in the Schedule hereto, being allowances paid to certain employees of the Post Office, shall be deemed to be salary for the purposes of Part II of the Superannuation Act 1956.

SCHEDULE

ALLOWANCES DEEMED TO BE SALARY

1. Allowance paid to a male First Division officer to make his remuneration equal to that of an officer who is on the maximum rank and file salary in the Second Division.

2. Allowance paid to an employee on his or her appointment at a lower salary and with retrospective effect from the Second Division to the First Division to restore his or her remuneration to its previous level.

3. Adult adjusting allowance paid to an adult female officer.
