THE SALE OF HONEY (EXPORT CONTROL) REGULATIONS
1971, AMENDMENT NO. 1

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 26th day of January 1976

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Primary Products Marketing Act 1953, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Sale of Honey (Export Control) Regulations 1971, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Sale of Honey (Export Control) Regulations 1971* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Metric amendment—Regulation 2 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting from subclause (2) the expression “10 lb” in each place where it occurs, and substituting in each case the expression “5 kg”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations make a metric amendment to the Sale of Honey (Export Control) Regulations 1971 which apply at present to any sale of more than 10 lb of honey. Under the amendment the governing quantity is changed from 10 lb to 5 kg (approximately 11.023 lb).
