THE SLAUGHTER OF LAMBS CONTROL ORDER 1947

PURSUANT to the Primary Industries Emergency Regulations 1939, the Minister of Agriculture hereby makes the following Order.

ORDER

1. This Order may be cited as the Slaughter of Lambs Control Order 1947.
2. This Order applies with respect to every lamb which when slaughtered and dressed will have a dressed weight not exceeding 30 lb.
3. No person shall sell or offer for sale or contract to sell for slaughter for human consumption in New Zealand any lamb to which this Order applies—
 - (a) Before the 3rd day of November, 1947, if that lamb has been raised in the North Island ; or
 - (b) Before the 24th day of November, 1947, if that lamb has been raised in the South Island.
4. No person shall purchase or offer to purchase or contract to purchase for slaughter for human consumption in New Zealand any lamb to which this Order applies—
 - (a) Before the 3rd day of November, 1947, if that lamb has been raised in the North Island ; or
 - (b) Before the 24th day of November, 1947, if that lamb has been raised in the South Island.
5. No person shall slaughter for human consumption in New Zealand any lamb the sale or purchase of which would be contrary to the foregoing provisions of this Order.
