

THE SALE OF POTATOES CONTROL ORDER 1942

Pursuant to the Primary Industries Emergency Regulations 1939,* I, James Gillispie Barclay, Minister of Agriculture, do hereby order and direct as follows.

ORDER.

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Sale of Potatoes Control Order 1942.
- 2. This Order shall come into force on the day following the date on which notification of the making thereof is published in the Gazette.
 - 3. (1) In this clause—

"Sale" includes barter and every other disposition for valuable consideration; and "sell" has a corresponding meaning:

- "Seed potatoes" has the same meaning as in Price Order No. 94†, issued by the Price Tribunal under the powers conferred on it by the Control of Prices Emergency Regulations 1939‡, and, in particular, includes potatoes that are deemed to be seed potatoes by virtue of clause 5 of that Order.
- (2) This clause applies with respect to seed potatoes being the produce of crops planted either in 1941 or in 1942 and dug not later than the 30th September, 1942, but does not apply with respect to any other seed potatoes.

(3) Except with the consent of the Primary Industries Controller given subject to any conditions that may be imposed by him—

- (a) No person shall sell any seed potatoes to which this clause applies unless he is satisfied on reasonable grounds that the potatoes are intended to be used as seed potatoes or are intended to be resold by the purchaser for use as seed potatoes; and
- (b) No person who in the course of any business carried on by him supplies meals to the public or to any person other than members of his own domestic household, or prepares or is engaged in the preparation of any tinned or other foods intended for sale, shall use any seed potatoes to which this clause applies for the purposes of such business.
- 4. Except with the consent of the Primary Industries Controller, no potatoes shall be bought or sold by a retailer otherwise than by weight.
