**ORDER**

**1. Title**—This order may be cited as the Stabilisation of Remuneration Act Commencement Order 1971.

**2. Commencement of Part III of Act**—Part III of the Stabilisation of Remuneration Act 1971 shall come into force on the 14th day of June 1971.
