Pursuant to section 456 of the Shipping and Seamen Act 1952, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Shipping (Certificate of Registry) Order 1969.
- (2) This order shall come into force 3 months after the date of its notification in the Gazette.
- 2. Form of certificate of registry—The Fifth Schedule to the Shipping and Seamen Act 1952 is hereby amended by revoking form A, and substituting the form A set out in the Schedule to this order.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order substitutes a new form of certificate of registry for ships registered in New Zealand under the Shipping and Seamen Act 1952.

Issued under the authority of the Regulations Act 1936. Date of notification in *Gazette*: 30 October 1969. This order is administered in the Marine Department.
