THE SHIPPING (ENGAGEMENT OF SEAMEN) EXEMPTION NOTICE 1975

PURSUANT to section 41A (4) of the Shipping and Seamen Act 1952 (as enacted by section 6 of the Shipping and Seamen Amendment Act 1971), the Minister of Transport hereby gives the following notice.

NOTICE

1. Title and commencement—(1) This notice may be cited as the Shipping (Engagement of Seamen) Exemption Notice 1975.

(2) This notice shall come into force on the 8th day of April 1975.

2. Exempted ships—The classes of ships specified in the Schedule to this notice are hereby exempted from the Shipping (Engagement of Seamen) Regulations 1975*.

SCHEDULE

EXEMPTED SHIPS

Fishing boats.

Ships which do not ply beyond restricted limits:

Provided that this exemption shall also apply to a ship which normally plies within restricted limits but proceeds beyond such limits—

- (a) In an emergency for the purpose of saving life at sea or rendering assistance to any ship, other vessel, aircraft, or person in distress at sea:
- (b) Under the authority of a permit granted under section 251 (2) of the Shipping and Seamen Act 1952 (as substituted by section 20 of the Shipping and Seamen Amendment Act 1963).

Home-trade ships under 25 register tons.

Ships owned and operated by a Harbour Board.

Pleasure yachts.
