HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 15 of the Finance Act, 1941, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby order as follows:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Superannuation (Definition of Salary) Order 1942, Amendment No. 1.
- 2. This Order shall be read together with and deemed to form part of the Superannuation (Definition of Salary) Order 1942* (hereinafter called the principal order).
- 3. This Order shall be deemed to have taken effect on the 1st day of April, 1946.
- 4. The Second Schedule to the principal Order is amended by adding thereto the following clause:—
- "(3) Allowance paid to a contributor who has become unable to perform his normal duties because his standard of colour perception, visual acuity, or hearing fails to reach the departmental standard or because of disablement attributable to service in any of His Majesty's Armed Forces established, whether in New Zealand or elsewhere, and who has consequently been reduced in status or pay."
