PURSUANT to the Superannuation Act 1956, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Superannuation (Definition of Salary) Order 1948, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Superannuation (Definition of Salary) Order 1948.*

(2) This order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 30th day of May 1975.

2. Special allowance deemed salary—The special allowance payable to a contributor in accordance with his rank and seniority as a legal officer of the regular forces permanently employed as such on a career basis shall be deemed to be salary for the purposes of Parts II and III of the Superannuation Act 1956.
