SUSPENSION ORDER UNDER THE WATERFRONT CONTROL COMMISSION EMERGENCY REGULATIONS 1940.

Suspension of Acts and Awards.

In pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the Waterfront Control Commission Emergency Regulations 1940, I, Patrick Charles Webb, Minister of Labour, do hereby order that the whole of the provisions of the New Zealand Waterside Workers' award dated the 30th day of November, 1937, and published in Book of Awards, Vol. XXXVII, p. 2529, shall be and they are hereby suspended in respect of their application to all of the ports in New Zealand, and I do hereby further order that, with the exception of the sections of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and its amendments specified in the Schedule hereto, the provisions of the Labour Disputes Investigation Act, 1913, and of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and its amendments shall be and they are hereby suspended in respect of their application to the workers coming within the scope of the said award.
