THE RIGHT HON. W. NASH PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Samoa Act, 1921, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Samoa Prisons and Constabulary Order 1929, Amendment No. 2.
2. These regulations shall be read with and deemed to form part of the Samoa Prisons and Constabulary Order 1929* (hereinafter called the principal order).
3. Clauses 11 and 12 of the principal order are revoked.
4. Clause 13 of the principal order is amended by inserting, after the words "from time to time", the following words: "by warrant under his hand published in the *Western Samoa Gazette*."
5. Clause 18 of the principal order is revoked.
6. The Samoa Prisons and Constabulary Amendment Order 1929 is revoked.
