Pursuant to the Samoa Act, 1921, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

#### REGULATIONS

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Samoa Prisons and Constabulary Order 1929, Amendment No. 2.
- 2. These regulations shall be read with and deemed to form part of the Samoa Prisons and Constabulary Order 1929\* (hereinafter called the principal order).
  - 3. Clauses 11 and 12 of the principal order are revoked.
- 4. Clause 13 of the principal order is amended by inserting, after the words "from time to time", the following words: "by warrant under his hand published in the Western Samoa Gazette."
  - 5. Clause 18 of the principal order is revoked.
- 6. The Samoa Prisons and Constabulary Amendment Order 1929 is revoked.
