



**THE SANITARY PLUMBING (PERMISSION FOR  
HOUSEHOLDERS) NOTICE 1984**

PURSUANT to to section 54 (3) of the Plumbers, Gasfitters, and Drainlayers Act 1976, and after consultation with each of the local authorities concerned, the Minister of Health hereby gives the following notice.

---

**NOTICE**

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) This notice may be cited as the Sanitary Plumbing (Permission for Householders) Notice 1984.

(2) This notice shall come into force on the 1st day of September 1984.

**2. Application of section 54 (1)**—(1) Section 54 (1) of the Plumbers, Gasfitters, and Drainlayers Act 1976 shall apply to every place specified in Part A of the Schedule to this notice.

(2) The said section 54 (1) shall apply to both places specified in Part B of the Schedule to this notice until the close of the 31st day of August 1985.

**3. Revocation**—The Sanitary Plumbing (Permission for Householders) Notice (No. 2) 1983\* is hereby revoked.

Clause 2

PLACES WHERE HOUSEHOLDERS MAY DO THEIR OWN SANITARY PLUMBING

Part A

Dannevirke County.

Ellesmere County.

Great Barrier Island County.

Manawatu County (excluding Foxton Beach Community, Himatangi Beach Community, and Tangimoana Community).

Rangitikei County (excluding Bulls Community, Hunterville Community, Koitiata Community, Mangaweka Community, and Ratana Community).

Rodney County (excluding the Hibiscus Coast Riding, Warkworth Community, Wellsford Community, Huapai, Matakana, Motutara, Omaha Beach, Parakai, Snells Beach/Algies Bay, and Te Makire).

Silverpeaks County (except those areas that are within 1 km of a residential zone, and except those premises that are connected to a public high pressure water supply).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

This notice applies section 54 (1) of the Plumbers, Gasfitters, and Drainlayers Act 1976 to the places specified in the Schedule. The effect is to allow the owner of any premises in such a place to personally do any sanitary plumbing in those premises (with or without the assistance of any member of his family living with him but without the assistance of any other person), if he resides or intends to reside in those premises by himself or with members of his family.

In respect of the places listed in Part A of the Schedule, the authority applies indefinitely. In respect of the places listed in Part B, it applies for 12 months only.
