



**THE SANITARY PLUMBING (PERMISSION FOR
HOUSEHOLDERS) NOTICE 1987**

PURSUANT to section 54 (3) of the Plumbers, Gasfitters, and Drainlayers Act 1976, and after consultation with each of the local authorities concerned, the Minister of Health hereby gives the following notice.

NOTICE

1. Title and commencement—(1) This notice may be cited as the Sanitary Plumbing (Permission for Householders) Notice 1987.

(2) This notice shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1987.

2. Application of section 54 (1)—Section 54 (1) of the Plumbers, Gasfitters, and Drainlayers Act 1976 shall apply to every place specified in the Schedule to this notice.

3. Revocation—The Sanitary Plumbing (Permission for Householders) Notice 1986* is hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This notice continues the application of section 54 (1) of the Plumbers, Gasfitters, and Drainlayers Act 1976 to Cheviot County and Wellington City. The effect is to allow the owner of any premises in that county or city to do personally any sanitary plumbing in those premises (with or without the assistance of any member of the owner's family living with the owner but without the assistance of any other person), if the owner resides or intends to reside in those premises with or without members of the owner's family. This authority was given in respect of that county and that city by the Sanitary Plumbing (Permission for Householders) Notice 1986 for a period of 12 months, and this notice continues that authority for a further 12 months.
