



THE SANITARY PLUMBING (PERMISSION FOR HOUSEHOLDERS) NOTICE 1992

PURSUANT to section 54 (3) of the Plumbers, Gasfitters, and Drainlayers Act 1976, and after consultation with the Rodney District Council, the Minister of Health hereby gives the following notice.

NOTICE

1. Title and commencement—(1) This notice may be cited as the Sanitary Plumbing (Permission for Householders) Notice 1992.

(2) This notice shall come into force on the 10th day of February 1992.

2. Application of section 54 (1)—Section 54 (1) of the Plumbers, Gasfitters, and Drainlayers Act 1976 shall apply to the Rodney District (excluding the land zoned for urban use in the district plan that, immediately before the date of this notice, is constituted, or deemed to be constituted, for the Rodney District under the Resource Management Act 1991).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This notice, which comes into force on 10 February 1992, applies section 54 (1) of the Plumbers, Gasfitters, and Drainlayers Act 1976 to part of the Rodney District.

The general effect of this notice is that, except in the part of the Rodney District zoned for urban use, a home owner may do personally any sanitary plumbing in his or her residence, with or without the assistance of any member of the owner's family living with the owner, but without the assistance of any other person.
