

## THE SANITARY PLUMBING (PERMISSION FOR HOUSEHOLDERS) NOTICE (NO. 4) 1992

PURSUANT to section 54 (3) of the Plumbers, Gasfitters, and Drainlayers Act 1976, and after consultation with the local authorities concerned, the Minister of Health hereby gives the following notice.

## NOTICE

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This notice may be cited as the Sanitary Plumbing (Permission for Householders) Notice (No. 4) 1992.
  - (2) This notice shall come into force on the 27th day of March 1992.
- 2. Application of section 54 (1)—Section 54 (1) of the Plumbers, Gasfitters, and Drainlayers Act 1976 shall apply to—
  - (a) The Tararua District:
  - (b) The Dunedin City except—
    - (i) Those areas that, on the coming into force of this notice, are within 1 km of a residential zone:
    - (ii) Those premises that, on the coming into force of this notice, are connected to a public high pressure water supply.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This notice, which comes into force on 27 March 1992, applies section 54(1) of the Plumbers, Gasfitters, and Drainlayers Act 1976 to—

- (a) The Tararua District:
- (b) The Dunedin City except-
  - (i) Those areas that, on the coming into force of this notice, are within 1 km of a residential zone:
  - (ii) Those premises that, on the coming into force of this notice, are connected to a public high pressure water supply.

The general effect of this notice is to allow a home owner in either of those places to do personally any sanitary plumbing in his or her residence, with or without the assistance of any member of the owner's family living with the owner, but without the assistance of any other person.
