## THE SANITARY PLUMBING (EXEMPTION) NOTICE 1966

PURSUANT to section 39 (1) of the Plumbers and Gasfitters Registration Act 1964, the Minister of Health hereby gives the following notice.

### NOTICE

1. (1) This notice may be cited as the Sanitary Plumbing (Exemption) Notice 1966.

(2) This notice shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. The places described in the Schedule to this notice are hereby specified as places where sanitary plumbing may be done by any person.

### SCHEDULE

The County of Ellesmere.

The County of Hobson.

The County of Raglan.

The County of Thames except

(a) The county town of Whangamata; and

(b) The land situated—

(i) Within half a mile of the Post Offices at Hikutaia, Matatoki, or Puriri; or

(ii) Within 1 mile of the Tairua Public Hall or of the junction of the two state highways in the locality popularly known as Kopu, or of the western boundary of the Hastings riding in the locality popularly known as Thames Coast.

### EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

The effect of this notice is that, subject to the provisions of any enactment other than the Plumbers and Gasfitters Registration Act 1964, sanitary plumbing may be done by any person in any of the places specified in this notice.
