ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 26th day of November 1984

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 212 of the Summary Proceedings Act 1957, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Summary Proceedings Regulations 1958, Amendment No. 12, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Summary Proceedings Regulations 1958* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of January 1985.

2. Default in payment of sum adjudged to be paid on conviction— Regulation 15H (1) of the principal regulations (as inserted by regulation 2 of the Summary Proceedings Regulations 1958, Amendment No. 7) is hereby amended by omitting the expression "\$30" (as substituted by regulation 2 (1) of the Summary Proceedings Regulations 1958, Amendment No. 11), and substituting the expression "\$50".

3. Court fees—The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the Second Schedule (as substituted by regulation 4 of the Summary Proceedings Regulations 1958, Amendment No. 11), and substituting the Second Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.

4. Revocation—The Summary Proceedings Regulations 1958, Amendment No. 11 are hereby consequentially amended by revoking regulations 2 (1), 4, and 5 and the Second Schedule to those regulations.

(2) The foregoing fees are not to be taken in proceedings under the Family Proceedings Act 1980, or in proceedings by way of complaint or in proceedings under Part V of the Summary Proceedings Act 1957."
